


# The community impact of North Carolina libraries



In 2014 NC public libraries surveyed the patrons who use their public access technology. This is what they found.

## Education libraries support education for people of all ages



Of those who had heard back at the time of this survey, **60%** were admitted to the program

## Employment libraries provide vital support to our workforce

**4 out of 10** library technology users use library resources for employment purposes.

**26%** used library computers to search for jobs

**20%** used library computers to apply for jobs

**20%** used library computers to work on a resume or cover letter

Of those:

- 43% got an interview
- 32% got a job offer

## eGovernment libraries connect people with government

34% of library technology users have used the library's computers or Internet to access government services or acquire government info

**14%** used library computers to acquire government forms

- Of those, **47%** used library computers to submit completed forms

**11%** used library technology to learn about gov't programs/services

- Of those, **36%** used library technology to apply for such services

## Health libraries provide technology to find health information

**28%** of library technology users have used the library to find health info and conduct health-related service transactions

**16%** used library computers to learn about diet and nutrition

- Of those, **85%** report this helped them decide to make changes to their diet

**17%** used library computers to learn about exercise or fitness

- Of those, **84%** report this helped them make changes in their exercise habits
